Jesus the Talk of the Town

1 Corinthians 1:1-9

1. Let's get more excited about Jesus than His messengers. 1:1
2. Let's brag on Jesus, not ourselves.
 - * Jesus unites us as His people. 1:2
 - * Jesus sets us apart for service. 1:2
 - * Jesus calls us into community with all believers. 1:2
 - * Jesus showers us with grace and peace. 1:3
3. Let's thank Jesus, the Giver, instead of showcasing our giftedness.

Sermon Reflection

for Individuals, Families, and Groups

1. If someone were to spend a week with you, what would they say you are passionate about?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 1:1. Paul refers to Himself as an apostle, or a messenger. Which is more important: the messenger or the message? What application can be made of this truth in our church culture today?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 1:2-3. In these two verses, what four reasons do we see to brag on Jesus, not ourselves?

Of these four, which one do you/we seem to need to remember the most?

4. Read 1 Corinthians 1:4-7. Do we tend to focus on people's giftedness more than we thank Jesus, the giver? What are the dangers of focusing on giftedness?
5. The "Voice" translation says in 1 Corinthians 1:6, "Your life story confirms the life story of the anointed One." If someone were to write your life story, Who would be your hero: the "best thing" that's ever happened to you? Who needs to hear your life story? When will you tell them?
6. What things lately might easily lead us to despair? Read 1 Corinthians 1:8-9. What encouragement do you find there?
7. Extra credit: Order one of the following simple commentaries, and read along as we venture through 1 Corinthians for the next five or six months:
