GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 4-YEAR-OLD/PRE-K & 5-YEAR-OLD/READINESS

Tuition fees: 4 days/week - \$215.00/month; 5 days/week - \$240.00/month

4-year/Pre-K:

- Children must be four years of age on or before August 31, 2009 (with the exception of children who were previously enrolled and are being "grandfathered" due to the change in cut-off dates from October 16 to August 31)
- One four-or five-day class, **Monday-Thursday (Friday optional)**. (Everyone attends Monday-Thursday. Friday may be added at any time during the year, but the additional day is permanent from that point on.)
- One five-day class, **Monday-Friday**.

Readiness:

- Children should be five years of age by January 1, 2010 to enroll.
- One readiness class, **Monday-Friday**.
- Current teachers must recommend readiness in order for a child to be considered for this class. (Readiness enrollment is subject to availability of space, with older children taking precedence.)

In order to guarantee your place, **the first month's non-refundable tuition is due no later than May 15, 2009** (or upon registration at a later date). Tuition is paid one month in advance. Registration fees are non-refundable, except for those moving out of town prior to August 1, 2009. **A \$75.00 yearly activity fee** (to partially cover the cost of wood/clay shop) **will be charged to all 4-year-old and readiness enrollees and is due by September 1, 2009.**

SPP Registration Worksheet

Thank you for completing the following worksheet to determine your rank for placement in the St. Paul's Preschool registration process. Once the information provided has been confirmed and registration forms have been reviewed, class assignments will be made in order of point totals. *Active* parishioners of St. Paul's Episcopal Church will receive priority based on length of membership (see below). As always, any child currently enrolled at St. Paul's Preschool is guaranteed a *space* (not necessarily first choice) for the 2009/2010 school year.

Rest assured that every effort will be made to accommodate your wishes and the needs of your children. However, at the discretion of the preschool director, an attempt may be made to equalize the number of boys and girls in a class, and this may cause the point count to be out of balance. Attempts will also be made to match Tiny Tots placement with that of older siblings. In the event of a tie for one remaining space in a class, #3 (below) will be the tie-breaker, followed by a random drawing, if necessary.

PLEASE NOTE—St. Paul's Preschool welcomes families in our community who are not currently affiliated with our church or our preschool. For those who are not parishioners of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, do not have a currently or previously enrolled child, or a parent is not an alumnus of St. Paul's Preschool, this pre-enrollment worksheet will not apply. Therefore, openings within the preschool (after affiliated persons have registered) will be available for other interested applicants to **register in person** on Monday, February 23 beginning at 11:00 AM.

[Non-affiliated out-of-town applications may be mailed in (postmarked by February 13, 2009). In situations where individuals are moving to Winston-Salem at a later date and are currently living out of town, a number, drawn at random and based on the number of mail-in applications plus the number of people in line at 11:00 AM on the day registration opens to the public, will be assigned to the mail-in applications.]
