

St. Paul's EYC Covenant Senior Ski Trip 2010

This covenant is a commitment that you are making to God, St. Paul's Episcopal Church, your youth leaders, and your peers so that our trip may be a good experience for all. Each trip should reflect what we understand the Christian life to be. Some of these "rules" are simply to abide the law; more importantly, they serve to remind us that living as a Christian comes with responsibility and is different than a lot of that which we encounter in the world around us.

Going on a trip with St. Paul's EYC should be viewed as a privilege, and participants are encouraged to grow in their Christian faith on the trip. If you breach the confidence of any of the following items, we reserved the right to send you home at your expense. All participants are asked to uphold standards that we follow as we grow and mature in our relationship with God and each other.

I acknowledge and accept that community life at a St. Paul's Episcopal Church sponsored event is based upon mutual trust, respect for others, and adherence to the Christian life and to the specifics of a set of principles which are:

- That the use of possession of alcohol, illegal drugs is prohibited;
- That the use possession of tobacco in any form is prohibited;
- That inappropriate sexual behavior, be it implied, consensual, or verbal is not tolerated;
- That the possession of fireworks, firearms, or weapons of any sort, including pocket knives is prohibited;
- That participants are expected to remain on the property which we are visiting throughout the time we are scheduled to be there;
- That acts of theft of violence or disrespect to fellow participants or leaders or the property of others or that of St. Paul's is prohibited;
- That riding in or driving a motor vehicle without specific permission from the Youth Minister or youth leaders is prohibited;
- That inappropriate language and behavior will not be used.
