St Paul's is planning our third trip to Camp Coast Care leaving Sunday, Feb. 21 and returning Sunday Feb. 28, 2010. The focus of the week will be working on individual homes doing a variety of jobs including sheetrock installation, carpentry, roofing, plumbing etc. Volunteer work crews are composed of individuals with all levels of skill. There are also on-campus jobs for volunteers that are vital to camp life including intake, kitchen and dining room assistants, facility and grounds maintenance, data entry, and general office work.
