Other talents, abilities and/or recommendations:

Christian Education. It shall be the responsibility of this committee, in consultation with the pastor(s), to provide educational opportunities for the congregation. In pursuit of this responsibility the committee shall have oversight of education for children and adults, including Sunday School and Vacation Bible School.

Evangelism. It shall be the responsibility of this committee (1) to lead the congregation in its outreach to the community to attract new members, (2) to operate a sponsor program which will assist new members to become integrated into the life of the congregation within the first six months after they join, (3) to institute whatever programs or methods necessary to retain members.

Property. It shall be the responsibility of this committee to see to the proper maintenance and protection of all property of the congregation, and to make certain that the same is kept in good repair.

Social Ministry. The responsibility of this committee shall be to encourage Christian compassion and outreach to people in the congregation or community who are in spiritual or physical need, where possible working in cooperation with other agencies engaged in aiding those in need.

Spiritual Life. It shall be the responsibility of this committee (1) to deepen the spiritual life of the congregation by providing devotional material for home use, (2) plan retreats, (3) encourage prayer and Bible study, (4) monitor the prayer chain, (5) oversee small group programs, and (6) procure from synod and ELCA source materials that aid in these responsibilities.

Stewardship. It shall be the responsibility of this committee to secure resources necessary to carry on the work of the Lord in this congregation. The committee shall also assist members to use their time and talents in service to the congregation and community.

Worship and Music. It shall be the responsibility of this committee to see that worship services are conducted regularly and properly. The committee shall have oversight of all activities related to the worship life of the congregation, such as altar service, acolytes, ushers, and worship materials.

Youth. It shall be the responsibility of this committee to identify and minister to the needs of the youth of the congregation.
