



Recap on the Winter Youth Conference



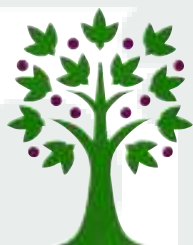
Over 150 youth responded to Adrain Depress sermon on Friday night, meeting with counselor's to talk more about how to live a Christian life style.
