



The Village experience, for babies up to 18 months, provides numerous benefits to the child and parents. Throughout the eight-week session, parents learn activities that aid their child's development. Singing, guided play and movement activities help babies develop improved hearing and balance in a positive emotional environment. The class creates a unique setting in which parents develop a better understanding of their child's developmental process. Observing other children and interacting with their parents provides valuable insights as well.

- Classes meet 45 minutes per week.
- Sessions are 8 weeks in length.
- There are 2 sessions each in fall and spring.
- Fall Session 1 meets August 13 through October 1 and Session 2 meets October 8 through December 3.
- You may enroll in one or both sessions.
- The classes will be on Wednesdays from 9:15-10:00 a.m. An additional evening class may form depending upon demand. If you are interested in an evening class, please indicate it on your registration form. You will be contacted regarding the formation of an evening class.

MATERIALS FEE AND TUITION

The materials fee of \$35 per session covers the cost of a packet for home use and **must accompany the registration to reserve space in the class. It is non-refundable.** The home packet includes a compact disc, a literature book, a wooden car instrument, art banners and a vinyl carry bag. Tuition for an eight-week session is \$84 in addition to the materials fee. Tuition is due on or before the first class day of the session. Withdrawals after the fourth week of class are obligated to pay the complete session tuition. For those needing to pay tuition in two installments, special arrangements can be made. 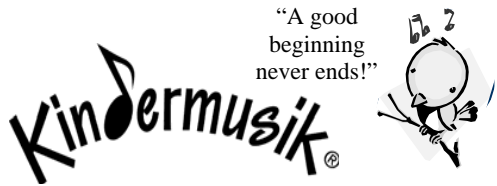
