## What does P.A.T.H. do?

**Resource and Referral Services:** You can call P.A.T.H. for information regarding a wide array of disability issues. If we don't have the answer you seek we will refer you to someone who does. Call us at 559-6217 and someone will get back to you.

**Equipment Loan Program:** Through a collaborative effort with Neighbor to Neighbor children's medical equipment and educational toys are available free of charge to families here in Door County. Check our website for a list of items.

**Sewing Ministry:** P.A.T.H. provides low cost weighted items for children with sensory integration needs. We offer weighted vests, neck snakes, lap pads and blankets. Contact us for an order form.

**Special Events:** P.A.T.H. plans quarterly events for families with special needs. Some events include speakers who provide educational opportunities for parents, teachers and other disability professionals. Some events are fun social events for families and are specifically designed with special needs children in mind. For upcoming events contact our office. Coordinator: Deb Doyle

**Summer Camp:** P.A.T.H. provides a 2 day per week summer camp that is 8 weeks long. The camp is available for all school age children. The camp ratio is 2 children to 1 provider. The camp director is a licensed special education teacher. Coordinator: Cheri Van den Bogart.

**Summer Tutoring Program:** P.A.T.H. provides low-cost tutoring for children with academic needs. The program is run by a licensed elementary school teacher. The program is open to all school age children. Coordinator: TBD

**Bike P.A.T.H. Program:** P.A.T.H. provides low-cost adaptive biking equipment for children with special needs and their families. This program will be available May-October 2010. The equipment is located up north at Inside the Park at the entrance to Peninsula State Park. P.A.T.H. members are able to use the equipment for free. You must contact the office for a free pass.

**Saturday Camp – Respite Program:** P.A.T.H. provides a respite day on the first Saturday of each month. This program is available to children and adults with special needs. Contact the office for more information. Coordinator: Diane Anderson

**Youth Group:** P.A.T.H. provides a monthly youth and young adult social outing. The group also participates in community service work throughout Door County. Contact us for more information. Coordinator: Diane Anderson

**Sunrise Bowling League:** P.A.T.H. provides a Saturday bowling league that runs from about Oct. thru April each year. It was taken over in 2010 from a dedicated group of parents who had previously run it for years. When no one came forward to continue to run it, P.A.T.H. agreed to take it over and work to keep it alive. This program serves 4th graders thru adulthood. Coordinator: Dawn Theory
