Ministry Opportunity Student Ministry	Brief Description	Key Questions (Level of Commitment)
Youth Snack Provider	Prepare a small meal or snack for teens for special events and activities	Would you be able to prepare a meal or snack for a group of people? Are you able to be creative and make something youth would eat? Time commitment would be 1-2 hours at event and time to prepare food.
Youth Praise Team Volunteer	Coordinate music, lead practice and be at performances.	Do you have a musical talent and would want to work with a group of youth? Time commitment is one hour practice determined by group and 1 to 1 1/2 hour worship on Wednesday night.
Substitute Teachers	Purpose to meet teaching needs of students in the absence of regular teachers. Be willing to teach any grade 7 <sup>th</sup> - 12 <sup>th</sup> on Sunday morning at 9:45 at The Spot.	Would you be willing to fill in for Sunday Bible Study teachers for grades 7 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> at the SPOT? Time commitment would be as needed for one hour.
Donation Coordinator	Obtain goods used for prizes, give-aways, etc. for student events.	Are you a self-starter, enjoy talking to people and have a gift of service? Could you ask for donations for upcoming events for the youth? Time commitment as needed for special events.
Mentors	Assist new teenage believers or seekers in understanding key biblical principles.	Would you like to help students grow in their spiritual walk? Time commitment would be long term, willing to meet regularly at least 3 times per month, and other times as needed.
Activity Drivers	Transport students to activity destinations while setting a good example of a safe driver.	Are you a good driver and don't get easily distracted by teenagers? Time commitment is as needed depending on frequency and length of activity.
First Impressions Team Coordinator	Direct a team of students on Wednesday nights or Sunday mornings to welcome and give visitor gift bags to new students. Oversee and coordinate a group of students to make home visits with visitors.	Are you willing to make visits to new students and visitors in order to make them feel welcome at NRBC? Time commitment is every Wednesday night and Sunday morning to hand out welcome bags and one time a month for home visits.
Youth Web Page Designer	Design and maintain a website that allows others to view the activities, events, ministries and purpose of the youth group.	Do you like working with computers and know how to build a web page? Time commitment would be as needed to set up the web page and then on an ongoing basis as needed to keep up to date.
Encouragement Team Coordinator	Contact students by phone, email or cards to provide encouragement. Contact first time visitors or students who have not been in regular attendance.	Do you like to keep in touch with people? Time commitment is weekly to check with Wes or secretary for birthdays or visitors who have not been around for a few weeks.

Ministry Opportunity Student Ministry	Brief Description	Key Questions (Level of Commitment)
Communications Coordinator	Design flyers, postcards and other forms of paper communication as needed by youth minister.	Would you like to work to keep students and parents informed about the youth ministry? Time commitment is weekly as needed.
Event Administrator	Maintain records and detailed information regarding youth activities. Organize volunteers, help with event bookkeeping and maintain necessary organizational forms for events.	Are you organized and like to prepare for events? Would you like to help so that Wes is free to focus on the actual event and kids? Time commitment varies and could be heavy depending on the event.
Special Teen Connections Advertiser	Help plan events and advertise such events to all participants and prospective participants. Coordinate overall event.	Do you enjoy designing flyers to announce upcoming events for special teens? Do you like to plan ahead, email and make phone calls to coordinate such an event?
Special Teen Connections Volunteer	Interact with teens with special needs at monthly socials held at The Spot. Second Saturday of each month from 7 to 9 pm.	Do you relate well to teenagers? Would you enjoy a commitment of only 2 hours per month? Do you enjoy playing games and socializing? Are you an encourager?
Special Connection Bible Study	<u>Teacher:</u> Teach teens and adults with special needs at 9:45 Sunday School hour.	Do you have an interest in helping others grow in their spiritual walk? Do you enjoy a slower paced class environment, with time for sharing and socializing?
Special Connection	<u>Helper:</u> Assist teacher with organizing class members, attending to their individual needs	Do you have an interest in sharing God with others, but don't feel confident in leading a class? Do you enjoy interacting with people, helping others feel comfortable in a group?
Special Connection	<u>Coordinator:</u> Assist with coordinating classroom activities and monthly social gatherings	Are you good at organizing group activities? Would you enjoy interacting with the parents of special needs class members? Would you have time to occasionally help with phone calls to class members?
Special Connection	<u>Outreach:</u> Assist Coordinator with classroom activities and monthly social gatherings	Would you be willing to write notes of encouragement, make phone calls and help plan activities as an assistant to the Special Needs Bible Study Coordinator?
College Ministry	A college and career group for ages 18-30 who meet weekly for Bible study and worship.	Do you feel you have the ability to connect with young adults? Do you want to build relationships with college age students? Time commitment is two hour weekly meetings and time to develop relationships.
