

## RELIGION TEACHER FOR GRADES 7 AND 8

The Franciscan School is currently accepting applications for the position of **Religion Teacher for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade**. This teacher is responsible for teaching the Catholic faith to middle school students and oversee the middle school religion program. The teacher will collaborate with the Office of Lifelong Formation in supporting middle school youth ministry. The teacher will actively engage students in their faith formation, academic instruction, and the development of the whole person.

Candidates must be a practicing Catholic, grounded in Vatican II principles of the faith, and hold a minimum of a bachelor's degree with a major/minor in Religious Studies/Theology. Applicants should be Master Catechists, in process of obtaining Master Catechist certification, or willing to pursue certification while employed.

The Franciscan School is part of the Education Ministry of the Catholic Community of St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Raleigh, North Carolina. The school was established in 2000 and is rooted in the Franciscan tradition. The Franciscan school provides a learning environment that embraces the Gospel values of the Roman Catholic faith.
