

NOTES /REMINDERS FROM ALTAR GUILD

- Please remember to use the blessed wine and wafers from the Aumbry to fill the LEM kits each week. We have been preparing the kits this way for over a year now, but some are still using the wine from the bottle in the sacristy cabinet.
- We have also been asked to discard any leftover wine in the LEM kits, rather than “saving” it to use the next week. It has been brought to our attention that the wine will go sour over time, so please be diligent in not pouring too much wine into the kits so we will not waste much. Remember, for the larger kits (TidePointe, Fraser Center) the bottle only needs to be *less than half full*. Individual kits just need about *a quarter or even less* full.
- We are not using bags of 50 wafers any longer but are filling the new flat silver box with 120 wafers (40 wafers in each compartment). We thank Jean DeVaty for finding and purchasing this box for us.
- Jean also purchased a crystal box for the rice wafers in the Aumbry. I know from conversation that some of you would like to make a donation towards either the silver box or the crystal box. If that is still the case, please let me, Jane or Tony know.
- Please remember to let the church office know if you are Captain and are getting a substitute for your shift.
