

## Student's ROC pick-up procedures

Students are asked to go to the drivers cars immediately after school. The drivers are generously donating their time, so we don't want them to wait any longer than necessary. Some will need to go pick up band instruments, the drivers will wait, just don't waste time chatting!

**All drivers will have an orange ribbon tied to the rear view mirror or the antennae on their car.**

**6<sup>th</sup> graders:** Drivers will park in the last row in the corner farthest from the school door (on the golf 7th coarse side and towards 129<sup>th</sup>). Walk on the sidewalk between the golf coarse and the parking lot towards the crossing guard, the drivers will be parked almost at the end of the row.

**7<sup>th</sup> graders:** Most 7<sup>th</sup> graders like to walk to St. Henry but we can provide a driver if necessary, please let me know if your youth would rather ride. If the weather is bad drivers will pick the youth up, the drivers will park just north of the maintenance building in the Ator elementary parking lot (look for the orange ribbon on the antennae or rearview mirror). **Please fill out both sides of the attached medical/ liability form.**

**8<sup>th</sup> Graders:** Drivers will park in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade parking lot across from the crosswalk. They may be back a couple rows so be sure to watch for them (look for the orange ribbon on the antennae or rearview mirror).

If a youth gets left at school (this seems to happen once each year), they should go into the school office and call and someone will come and get them immediately.
