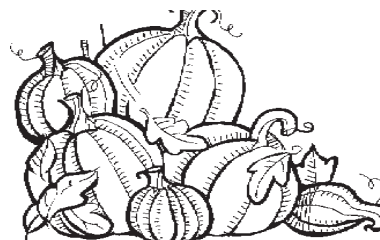
Bring Canned Goods for Salvation Army
