Father's Day

The first observance of Father's Day is believed to have been held on July 5, 1908 by Dr. Robert Webb at the Williams Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church South in Fairmont, West Virginia. It was Sonora Smart Dodd who arranged a tribute to her father on June 19, 1910 in the Central Methodist Episcopal Church in Spokane, Washington. Mrs. Dodd was the first to solicit having an official Father's Day observance to honor all fathers. In 1926, a National Father's Day Committee was formed in New York City.

In 1956, Father's Day was recognized by a Joint Resolution of Congress. In 1972, President Richard Nixon established a permanent observance of Father's Day to be held on the third Sunday of June.

This Sunday, June 21, is Father's Day. During all services we will be honoring Dads and CFUMC has a gift for all men in attendance. We hope this is a special day for all fathers. Let me leave you with the following two thoughts:
Any man can be a Father, but it takes a special person to be called Dad!
