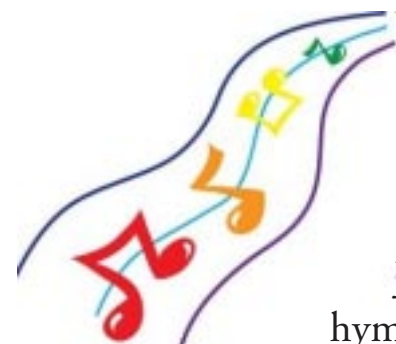

Thank you for your support of the Nicaragua Medical Mission Team. Many people received medical care because you care.

Two special projects are ongoing from this trip. We are involved in helping the Los Playones and Pueblo Nuevo communities to get a medical clinic. They are about 100 miles from established medical centers and travel is difficult. Our team was able to commit a small amount to the building of the clinic and left money for training of nurses.

Our team plans to return yearly to help train and to hold clinics.

The second project is helping the Los Playones community improve their school and strengthen their educational program. \$600 will provide paint, teacher's desk, repairs, equipment, security, etc. for the classrooms (6 rooms). A kitchen is being furnished so the children will have a meal at school. Eight hundred dollars have been spent to buy books (1 per 5 students).

The classes average about 45 per classroom. The local people are having work days to make improvements such as repairing desks, windows, doors, and painting.
