Projects for 2010

Category A – Will Serve in Area of Greatest Need

Category B - Before the Great Day of Service

B1 - BAKE COOKIES: Bake cookies and bring to church on Friday, March 26 or by 9 a.m. Saturday, March 27. Cookies will be delivered to police and fire stations and taken to the various GDS picnics. *All ages.*

B2 - INVENTORY AND SHOP:

Inventory donated items and shop for additional needs from Donation Wish List prior to GDS March 27. (Great for members who can't make GDS date.) *Adults.*

B3 - LETTER WRITERS: Write personal letters to be sent to members of congregations in partner churches in Serbia. *All ages.*

B4 - MURAL DESIGN: Volunteers artistically gifted will form a committee to design murals for 2 locations. *Adults.*

B5 - SEW - PROJECT 1: Sew hospice gowns and bibs at home, and deliver to the church on Friday, March 26, or on Saturday, March 27. *Adults.*

B6 - SEW - PROJECT 2: Sew quilt tops at home, and deliver to the church on Friday, March 26, or on Saturday, March 27. *Adults.*

Category C – Carpentry

C1 - CANDLER UNITED METHODIST CHURCH: Replace metal lockers with manufactured wooden cabinets and deliver metal lockers to Good News at Noon. *Adults.*

C2 - CHICOPEE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH: Help build and install coverings for wells under windows to prevent water leakage. *Adults.*

C3 - CHILDREN'S CENTER FOR HOPE AND HEALING - Project 1: Construct two interior walls to create new office spaces in existing office. *Adults.*

C4 - GOOD NEWS AT NOON: Replace damaged, missing, and discolored ceiling tiles. *Adults.*

C5 - HOSPICE OF NORTHEAST GEORGIA MEDICAL CENTER: Build wooden memory boxes from patterns. *Adults.*

C6 - MEALS ON WHEELS: Repair roof for elderly Meals on Wheels client. *Adults.*

C7 - OUR NEIGHBOR: Cover and secure eight screened openings with thick plastic to prevent rain damage on screened porch at Randy's House. *Adults.*

C8 - WAUKA MOUNTAIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: Construct 6 raised beds for horticulture classes. *Adults.*

Category D - On the Great Day of Service

D1 - NURSERY AND PRESCHOOL CHILDREN'S GREAT DAY OF SERVICE PROJECTS: Help nursery and preschool children of parents participating with GDS to finish a mission project for community infants and children. *16 & up.*

D2 - KID'S CAMP: Help with Kid's Camp for children (K - 5th Grade) of parents involved with GDS. *14 & up.*

D3 - DAY OF VOLUNTEERS - KICK-OFF: Assist Day of Service Coordinators with the kick-off activities on the Great Day. *Adults.*

D4 - DAY OF VOLUNTEERS - SUNDAE CELEBRATION: Help with the Sundae Celebration. *14 & up.*

D5 - PHOTOGRAPHERS: Visit the many locations where Great Day of Service Projects are taking place and take pictures / video of the activities. *Adults.*

D6 - STAN'S CREW: After the dust has settled on GDS Saturday, prepare the church for Sunday worship. *Adults.*

Category G - Activities at GFUMC

G1 - BAGGING COOKIES: Bag cookies for delivery to police and fire stations. (Other GDS teams will deliver the cookies.) *14 & up.*

G2 - CHALLENGED CHILD AND FRIENDS - PROJECT 1: Fill 700 Easter Eggs for Challenged Child and Friends Egg Hunt. *6 & up.*

G3 - FIRE AND POLICE STATIONS: Deliver cookies to designated fire and police stations. Thank you notes to the firemen and police officers for keeping us safe could be included. A good project for families with children. *6 & up.*

G4 - GFUMC CHILDREN'S MINISTRY - YBS: Prepare backdrop / scenery for 2010 Vacation Bible School. *13 & up.*

G5 - GFUMC CHOIR ROOM: Clean and organize choir room and loft as needed. *Adults.*

G6 - GFUMC COURTYARD: Clean outside windows in courtyard and building. *10 & up.*

G7 - GFUMC INDOOR CLEANING - GREAT ROOM, FELLOWSHIP HALL & HALLWAY, GATHERING ROOM: Wash windows and dust blinds as needed. *10 & up.*

G8 - GFUMC INDOOR CLEANING - SANCTUARY / CHAPEL - PROJECT 1: Clean church pews, vacuum and dust all wood, and clean windows. *10 & up.*

G9 - GFUMC LAKESIDE AND SCOUT CABIN: Clean up debris outside Scout Cabin and around Lakeside Service site; prune bushes as needed. *12 & up.*

G10 - GFUMC SANCTUARY / CHAPEL - PROJECT 2: Remove pencil and information holders from pews and discard old broken pencils; replace with new pens, and replenish information packets. *Adults.*

G11 - PRAYER SHAWLS: Meet at the church and knit or crochet prayer shawls for GFUMC's Congregational Care Ministry. Beginners are welcome. Instructions will be provided. *All ages.*

G12 - SEWING AND SEWING HELPERS - PROJECT 1: Cut fabric and/or sew gowns and bibs for hospice patients. *Adults.*

G13 - SEWING AND SEWING HELPERS - PROJECT 2: Cut fabric and/or sew prayer quilts for hospice patients. *Adults.*

G14 - TRAY FAVORS: Make tray favors to share with patients. These are cards with Bible verses, notes, and get-well wishes that are placed on lunch trays at Northeast Georgia Medical Center and area nursing homes. *All ages.*

G15 - UMCOR AND OTHER MISSIONS: The United Methodist Committee on Relief is at work around the world providing assistance to people in need. GDS will support its efforts by providing school supplies and health kits. GDS volunteers will assemble the kits, pack donations, and prepare for shipping. *14 & up.*

Category I - Indoor Projects

I1 - CENTER POINT: Clean windows and perform a general cleaning of inside building. *16 & up.*

I2 - CHALLENGED CHILD AND FRIENDS - PROJECT 2: Help clean-up individual classrooms to include cleaning tables, chairs, toys, etc. *16 & up.*

Category O - Outdoor Projects

O1 - BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF HALL COUNTY - PROJECT 1: Distribute pine straw in beds and area next to building from "The Club" sign in front of building all the way around both buildings. *Adults.*

O2 - CHALLENGED CHILD - PROJECT 3: Pressure wash fence around air conditioners and

trailer steps. *Adults.*

O3 - EAGLE RANCH: Clear branches and limbs in outdoor area and spread mulch. *13 & up.*

O4 - GAINESVILLE ACTION MINISTRIES: Perform major clean-up with grass cutting, weed eating, raking, etc. *16 & up.*

O5 - GAINESVILLE CARE CENTER: Provide facility maintenance for the house and grounds; this will include power wash siding, cleaning front gutters, trimming bushes, pulling weeds, mulching beds, and cleaning up parking lot. *16 & up.*

O6 - GAINESVILLE HALL COUNTY ALLIANCE FOR LITERACY: Sand and paint outside railing, plant ground cover and put out pine straw. *Adults.*

O7 - GATEWAY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CENTER: Pressure wash vinyl siding buildings, clean gutters, and put out pine straw in all beds. *Adults.*

O8 - HUMANE SOCIETY OF NORTHEAST GEORGIA - PROJECT 1: Clean up dog run, spread mulch, and anchor fence where dogs have dug underneath. *16 & up.*

O9 - MAYSVILLE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH: Landscaping of church grounds (might include planting shrubs and preparation of flower beds). *13 & up.*

O10 - NORTHEAST GEORGIA SPEECH CENTER, INC. - PROJECT 1: Clean and repair playground toys and equipment. *Adults.*

O11 - REHABILITATION INDUSTRIES OF NORTHEAST GEORGIA: Prepare flower beds with soil amendments and pine straw. *Adults.*

O12 - SUNSHINE SENIORS: This project involves yard clean-up for 6 members of the Sunshine Seniors. This is an organization of predominately African American women who, in coordination with the Health Department, have quarterly lunch meetings and activities to encourage good health. *14 & up.*

Category P - Painting

P1 - ALPINE GAINESVILLE (Old Gainesville Middle School): Patchwork painting of walls to match all other walls. (Concrete block walls that have damage, not complete rooms.) *Adults.*

P2 - BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF HALL COUNTY - PROJECT 2: Paint lower 4 feet of wall to hide marks. (30' x 20' Room). *16 & up.*

P3 - GAINESVILLE-HALL COUNTY SENIOR LIFE CENTER: Paint 2 (10' x 13') rooms. *16 & up.*

P4 - HALL-DAWSON CASA PROGRAM: Paint mural on playroom walls; design will be drawn prior to day of GDS. *16 & up.*

P5 - HUMANE SOCIETY OF NORTHEAST GEORGIA - PROJECT 2: Paint conference room, public bathrooms and conference hallway. *16 & up.*

P6 - NORTHEAST GEORGIA SPEECH CENTER, INC. - PROJECT 2: Paint mural on inside walls; design will be drawn prior to day of GDS. *16 & up.*

P7 - OUR NEIGHBOR - PROJECT 2: Spray paint picket fence in front yard, and paint front door. (Randy's House) *16 & up.*

P8 - OUR NEIGHBOR - PROJECT 3: Paint floor of screen porch. Some heavy furniture will be moved off floor and then back. (Randy's House) *16 & up.*

Category S - After the Great Day of Service

S1 - SHIPPING: Take boxed donations to be shipped. *Adults.*

Category V - Visitations

V1 - ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES: Sing, entertain, and provide an ice cream social for the residents of at least 3 assisted living facilities. *Adults/families.*

V2 - BAKER GLOVER MOBILE HOME PARK: Provide a hotdog cookout along with games for the children. *Adults/families.*

V3 - COMMUNITY HOSPITALITY TENTS: Volunteers will offer a friendly greeting and hospitality to shoppers coming to J & J Foods. They will provide refreshments and information about our church. An orientation for GDS volunteers will be provided. Spanish speaking a plus. *10 & up.*

V4 - JONES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: Help with an Easter Egg Hunt and other fun activities for the children. *Adults/families.*

V5 - MEALS ON WHEELS: Meals on Wheels is generally a weekday program. GDS will enable the MOW clients to enjoy a special treat on a Saturday when they are delivered donated meals. Route maps and detailed delivery instructions will be provided. *Adults/families.*

V6 - WHITE SULPHUR ELEMENTARY: Provide a hotdog cookout and Easter egg hunt. *All ages.*
