Last, when people do back out, it is not fair to the others going on the trip because their cost may increase due to travel and gas expenses. 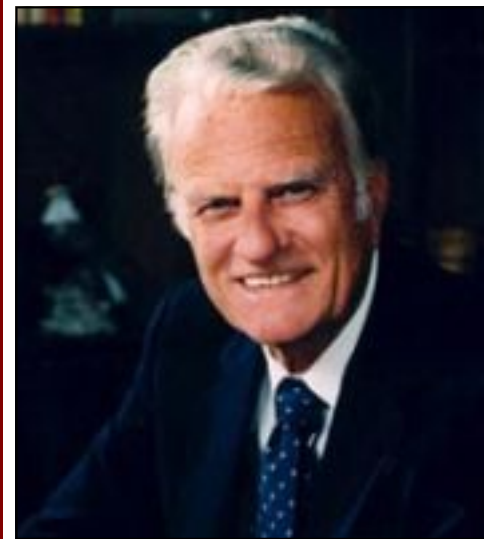

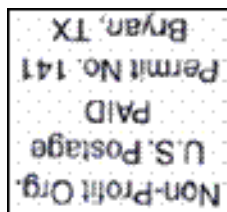
