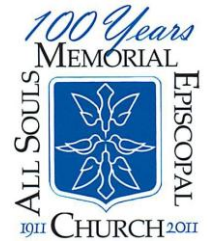

## ALL SOULS AND EPISCOPAL RELIEF AND DEVELOPMENT

This Sunday we welcome Dr. Robert W. Radtke, president of Episcopal Relief and Development, as our preacher at both Masses. Rob will also lead a special Adult Forum at 10 a.m. I encourage you to welcome him and engage him in conversation about this great organization and its work in the United States and around the world.

Whenever there has been a national or international disaster, we have used ERD bulletin inserts to encourage participation and giving. Also, the vestry has asked our endowment board to make special grants. In 2011 we gave \$5,000 for the rebuilding effort of the Cathedral complex in Haiti and an additional \$5,000 for ongoing relief in Haiti. Immediately after the earthquake in 2010, \$10,000 was sent to Haiti. We also gave \$5,000 for tsunami relief in Japan and \$5,000 for tornado relief in the US. Our own Flo McAfee serves on the board of Episcopal Relief and Development and Erwin de Leon served as interim community relations officer while in New York City. As we welcome Rob Radtke, we look forward to our ongoing relationship with ERD and continue to listen for God's call to mission and love. *John Beddingfield*

**HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY . . .** We have made considerable progress since we rolled out our initial handicap accessibility design last September. Earlier this week, the architect reviewed his schematic design with the Rector and Senior Warden. This design adds a great deal of detail to the initial design that you have seen and is needed for a meeting with the Historic Preservation Review Board and the Preliminary Design Review with the DC Regulatory Agency on February 29. The next steps include obtaining a more specific cost estimate and planning and conducting a capital campaign.

**ALL SOULS ROCKS . . .** All Souls Rocks raised over \$10,000, which is being matched with a \$10,000 challenge grant from the Endowment. **WE STILL WELCOME YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS** as the work is not yet on contract and we want to do as much as we can now, before we face a crisis with falling stone. Checks made out to All Souls

Memorial Episcopal Church with a note indicating that they are for All Souls Rocks can be placed in the collection. One can also contribute online through our web site.

**STAINED GLASS RESTORATION . . .** Thanks to an \$8,500 grant from the MARPAT Foundation and an anonymous gift of \$8180 from a parishioner, restoration of the large Goodhue Window at the rear of the sanctuary will begin in the spring. If you notice the four lancet windows at the rear of the church, you'll note that St. Luke is a good deal brighter than the other three Evangelists. About a year ago, the heavy grate with a corroded screen that covered Saint Luke fell off and a parishioner gently washed the window. We could restore all four of the Lancet windows for \$1,500 each, while work is being done on the Goodhue Window. One parishioner has already donated funds to cover one window--if you'd be willing to donate \$1,500 to restore one of the Evangelists, please talk to the Senior Warden.

**WANTED . . .** Someone to review our building and liability insurance with the Church Insurance Corporation to make sure that our insurance policies are adequate. *Why this is important:* Our insurance coverages were last reviewed about ten years ago. It is clearly prudent to review those coverages ASAP. Ideally, we are looking for someone with experience with commercial property and liability insurance, but, in the absence of that sort of experience, we'll be glad for help from anyone who would be willing to take this on. *Estimated time commitment:* 10 hours whenever convenient for the volunteer. *Volunteering:* Contact one of the Wardens or any Vestry Member if you are willing to help . . . **Also Wanted:** 1) Someone to support the All Souls Are Green team in earning an Energy Star Congregation status for All Souls Memorial Episcopal Church and 2) Someone to develop a building use policy for non-All Souls groups which use our property. . .
