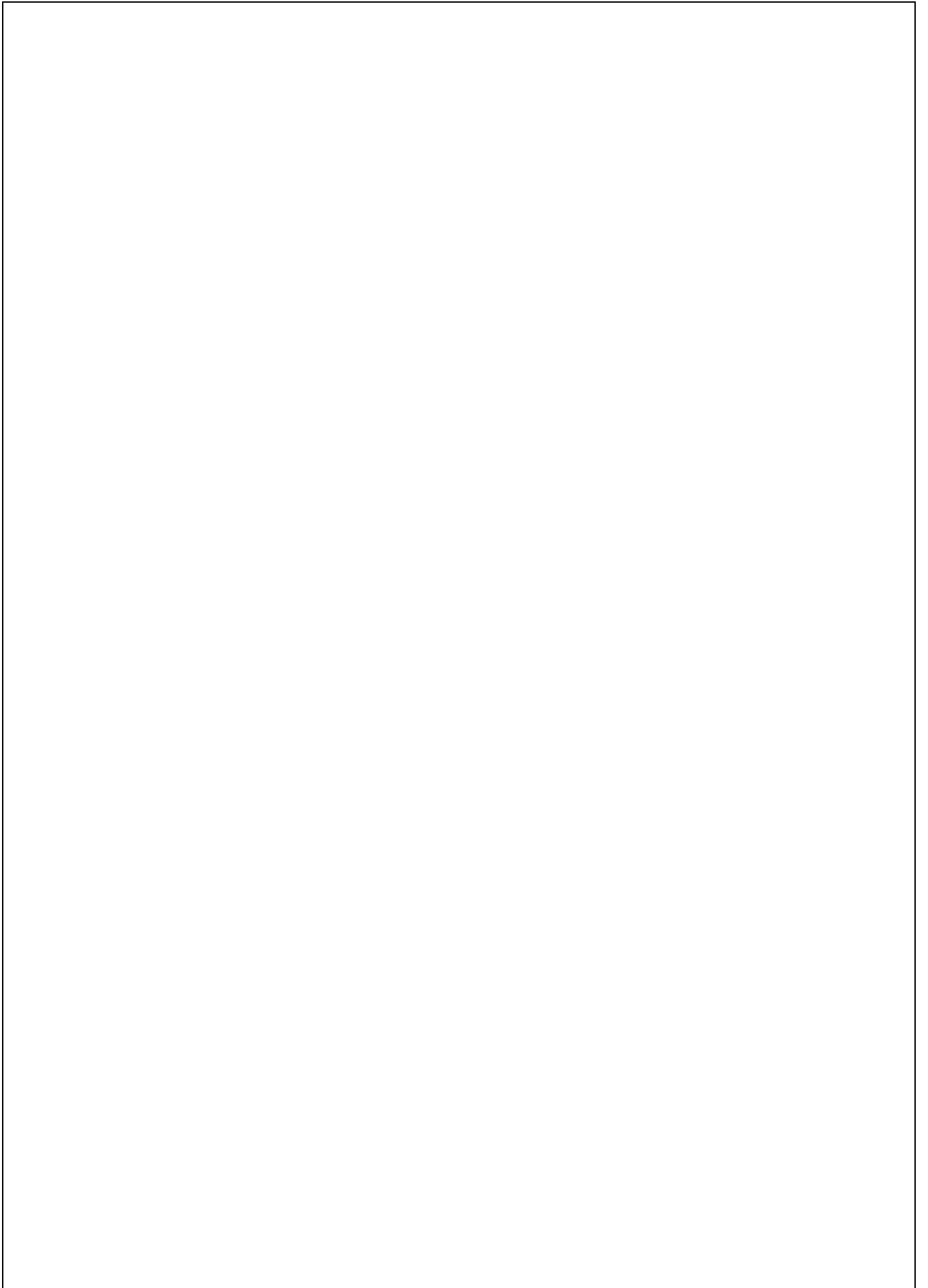

APPLICANTION COMMITMENTS AND PROCESS:

1. School Grade: 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th as of the spring semester of 2011-12 school year.
2. Be active in your Youth Groups and Sunday School (Bible Study, Retreats, and Special Events) and attend Sunday morning services (especially 11 o'clock services) at least once a month, but church membership is not required.
3. Participate in the following Youth Fundraisers—
 - a. "Take-Stock-In-Mission" (Feb-Aug)
 - b. "Youth Auction Luncheon" (Sunday Mar. 25, 12:15-1:30 pm)
 - c. "Car Wash" (Saturday, Apr. 14, 9 am – 3 pm)To be excused from these fundraising activities you must get a permission from the Youth Council prior to those events, and help prepare or/and follow up any works related to those events.
4. Be involved in any church and community service activities, including, but not limited to: All Church Workday, Souper Bowl of Caring, Meals on Wheels, Coffee Fellowship Service on Sundays, any services related to MAM, Mission of YAHWEH, Star of Hope, Women's Home, Sherwood Community, or Presbytery (PYCC and Youth Celebration).
5. Attend all three training meetings:
 - a. Training 1: Sunday, Feb. 19, 2012, 5-6 PM in W-14
 - b. Training 2: Sunday, Apr. 22, 2012, 5-6 PM in W-14
 - c. Training 3: Sunday, July 22, 2012, 5-6 PM in W-14
6. All applications must be received with a deposit of \$150 by noon, Sunday, Feb. 19, 2012. The participant's fee for the trip is \$550 per person. All checks are made payable to Pines Presbyterian Church with the memo of "High School Guatemala Trip Fee."
 - (Optional) Installment Plan Schedule:
 - a. \$100 due on Mar. 24, 2012 (the 1st payment)
 - b. \$100 due on Apr. 29, 2012 (the 2nd payment)
 - c. \$100 due on May 29, 2012 (the 3rd payment)
 - d. \$100 due on July. 22, 2012 (the final payment)
7. An applicant may request and receive a "need-based" scholarship by turning in the "Pines Youth Mission Scholarship Application" by Feb. 19, 2012 along with the other forms for the trip.
