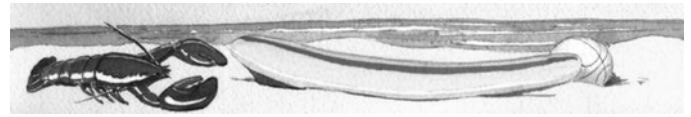
INCARNATION SENIORS
