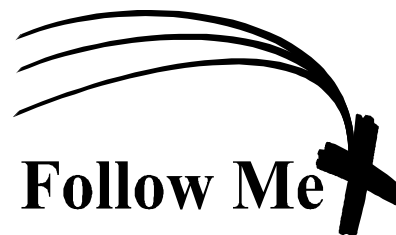

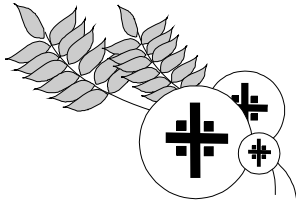

BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL**

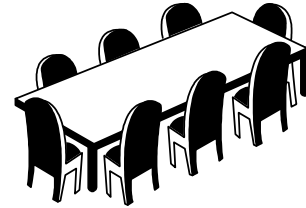

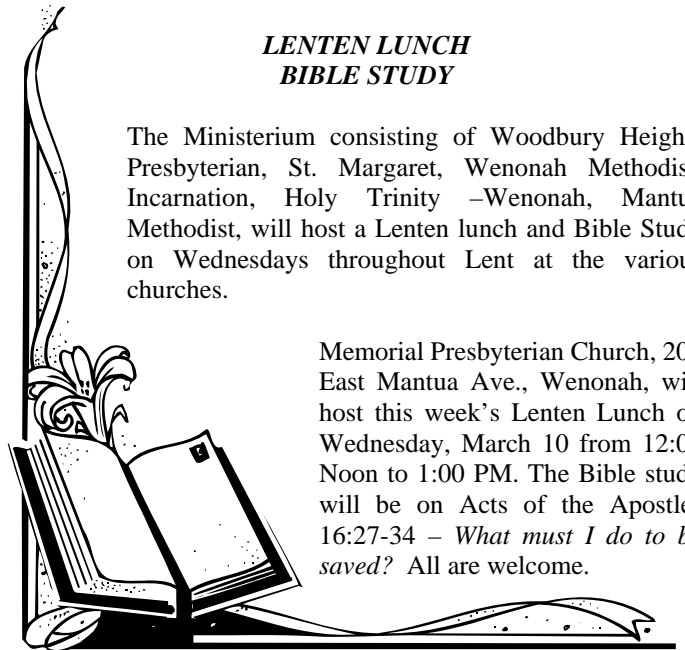
EASTER BASKETS
