Helpful Tips

- Your child's cubby should contain the following items: change of clothes and a blanket for nap time. Please label all personal items.
- Backpacks, diaper bags and cubbies should not contain any items that should be kept out of the reach of children. Diaper rash cream, hand sanitizer, and other unsafe items should be labeled and given to the teachers. *Please see your child's teachers for specific classroom requirements.*
- Please be sure to send your child to school in safe shoes each day. Open-toe sandals, crocs, dress shoes, and cowboy boots are not safe for school.
- Due to life-threatening allergies, it is imperative that no peanut products be brought to school. Check with your child's teacher before bringing any other food products into the classroom.
- Each child must be signed in and out each day. Sign-in sheets are posted in each classroom.
- Children should arrive at school no later than 9:30 a.m. each day and 9:00 a.m. in Pre-K. Please call if you will be late or absent.

Transition



The new school year is exciting, but can also be a bit overwhelming. Talk to your child about all of the wonderful things they will experience and get to know their teachers. If you are comfortable, your child will be, too. Some children will have a great first week and later on separation anxiety will set in. This is normal and the teachers are there to help them through it. You can help by giving hugs and kisses and letting them know that you will be back later, then say good-bye and leave. The longer you stay, the longer they take to adjust.
