ROCKsolid Wednesdays

Wednesdays, 6-8pm

Middle School and High School Youth meet each Wednesday evening to take part in various activities, projects, games, and conversations focused around a different topic each month. We come together for dinner at 6pm in the Cafeteria, and then split into grade level age groups to experience the evening’s activities. One Wednesday of each month is devoted to Mass and free time, large group games, experiences of discipleship, or service.

Sundays, 9:05-10:25am

Additional opportunities for Faith Formation for ROCKsolid Youth occur throughout the school year on Sunday mornings before the 10:30am Mass. Middle School and High School youth are invited to take part in faith-forming Bible Studies from the “Great Adventure” Series for Teens that include dynamic videos, workbooks, and lively conversations.

Confirmation Preparation

Sunday Evenings

Youth in their Junior Year of High School will be eligible to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They will meet on Sunday either before or after the Sunday evening Mass. The exact time and dates will be announced in the early fall. Confirmation candidates will complete a separate registration form which will be available in September.
