

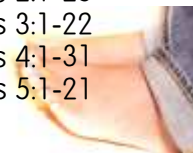
God wants to have a relationship with each one of us. One of the main goals of this message series is to experience God in our daily lives and grow personally.

Throughout the next six weeks we are going to read the book of Exodus from the Old Testament. This book was written by Moses as a first-hand account of how he experienced God in real ways every day as he led the nation of Israel, God's chosen people, out of slavery from Egypt. The first half of the book talks about God's amazing activity to rescue His people. The last half contains the regulations God gave Moses for Israel. As you read Exodus, look for important lessons that apply to your life. God wants to work in your life just like He did in Moses' life.

As you read each day, ask yourself the following questions about the passage and your life:

- What is discussed? What is happening?
- How does this passage fit into what happened before and after?
- How is God using this to speak to me?
- What do I learn about God?
- What are the promises I can trust God to keep?
- What are the commands to obey?
- How can I pray about what God is teaching me?

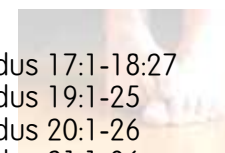
