**Eph.2:12-14**

The senior pastor's three-year vision for Liberty.

I See the Lord Jesus Christ breaking down human barriers within the body of Liberty, reaching our community through the witness of a transformed Christian family, and pouring His Spirit upon "One Church, All People."

**I. Remember Being Separated from Christ (v.12).**

**A. Remember when you were spiritually l\_\_\_\_\_.**  
Oh the misery of a lost soul.

**B. Remembering provides us necessary v\_\_\_\_\_.**

1. Remembering is necessary to value o\_\_\_\_\_ status in Christ.
2. Remembering is necessary to value the status of o\_\_\_\_\_ people.

**II. Remember Being Brought to Christ**

**A. Remember when you were b\_\_\_\_\_ to Christ (v.13a). Oh the joy of our salvation!**

**B. Jesus' b\_\_\_\_\_ brought you to Christ (v.13b).**

1. You did not bring yourself to Christ.
2. Jesus paid the price by His blood.

III. Jesus Breaks Down Barriers and Makes Christians One  
(v.14)

A. Jesus breaks down barriers of d\_\_\_\_\_.

1. In Jesus' culture the greatest dividing wall was Jewish and Gentile barriers.
2. In our culture the greatest dividing wall is White and Black barriers.
3. What would God do if the walls of division came down at Liberty? Revival!

B. Jesus brings p\_\_\_\_\_ together.

1. The word peace means to reconcile or bring pieces together.
2. Jesus' blood gives us peace; this peace brings us together with all people.
3. Many churches WELCOME different people, but few churches UNITE with other people.

C. Our participation in a united body is the greatest  
w\_\_\_\_\_ to a divided world (John 17:21).

Conclusion: Dare we sit at the Lord's Table to eat, and participate in Holy Communion, if we are not cooperative in being one body!
