



Dear Liberty Family,

Blessings! What an exciting time in the life of Liberty Baptist Church! The Lord is at work in our church! Can you see the vision He has given us? For years we have been aware of our need for additional Sunday School space, fellowship space, and multipurpose space. We have prayed and sought the Lord faithfully. The beautiful lake behind our existing fellowship hall prohibited us from expanding eastward. It appeared we were landlocked. However, God took an obstruction and made it a resource. The Lord led our neighbor to donate 1.77 acres of land. This provides sufficient space to expand northward. Years ago our church sought to purchase this land but was unable to do so. The Lord had a better plan. Our Lord purposed to have it donated! The lake will be used for ministry. It will provide a prayer trail and community fishing. God is at work!

Here is how the proposed building fits into God's vision for meeting our need. First, visualize an additional 240 people attending Bible study on Sunday morning. The proposed new addition encompasses 16 classrooms, plus a large recreational floor that can accommodate many more people. Second, visualize the Liberty family fellowshiping at tables in the same room. Currently we have to utilize the youth wing and individual Sunday School classrooms for church-wide fellowships. The new building enables the Liberty family to eat in the same room. Third, visualize Liberty and community families utilizing the recreational facilities for fun and safe leisure. People will no longer go to the mall to walk, but they can enjoy the safe and inviting facilities of Liberty. Children will be reached through Upward Basketball. Youth will be reached through volleyball and a game room. There will be recreation for everyone. Fourth, visualize Liberty enjoying and reaching the community through the café. The café will provide a daily soup and sandwich lunch. Coffee will be served at the café on Sundays and during special events. Immediately outside the café will be a patio overlooking our lake. Liberty and the community will enjoy this attractive environment to become acquainted and fellowship. Fifth, visualize a Christian and family bookstore onsite. The additional space will permit us to transform our existing office suite into a Christian bookstore. The church and community can purchase Bibles, Christian books, and family mementos. This is just the beginning!

Our Capital Building and Expansion Team has worked over a year tirelessly. The building plan meets our vision and need. The Capital Stewardship Campaign is biblical, respectful, and practical. God has spoken and your Leadership Team has made the enclosed preparations. Now all of us must do our part to achieve God's vision. While the three million dollar projected cost is sizable, our Lord is sufficient. I ask you to seek the Lord and do your part – nothing more and nothing less. God is the Great Builder. He builds His house. Yet we must obey in providing physical space for those He sends.

Let me say, "Thank you" in advance. We believe in following the Lord Jesus Christ by faith. This is a great step of faith. God rewards faith. Read this booklet carefully. Pray in faith deliberately. Remember, "For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God" (Hebrews 3:4). I love the saints of Liberty dearly.
