Ephesians 6:10-24 *For we are not fighting against people made of flesh and blood, but against persons without bodies—the evil rulers of the unseen world, those mighty satanic beings and great evil princes of darkness who rule this world; and against huge numbers of wicked spirits in the spirit world.* (v.12) Sometime ago our church held a parish weekend retreat on the church property. The main speaker was very dynamic, and his topic the first night was warnings about the reality of evil spirits. No one noticed a young man slip into the meeting until he was suddenly behind the altar, holding the crucifix by its long wooden handle. He began screaming obscenities and calling the speaker a liar in frightening language. He smashed the crucifix over the altar, breaking it into two halves, and began to threaten the speaker with the jagged point of the spear he had just created. He was finally subdued and taken away by the police. There was little doubt in anyone's mind that they had seen the presence of evil spirits manifested in the young man. The speaker continued, and never have I seen such rapt attention in an audience. We knew from what we had just witnessed that the message was real.
