

SENIOR HIGH YOUTH SUMMER OPPORTUNITIES

Senior High Youth – It's not too early to begin to think about summer activities even though it's cold and snowy outside! Please look over the summer opportunities below to see if any interest you. 1. "**Convergence: Where Faith and Science Meet**" is a 9-day program (June 23-July 1, 2018) that allows rising 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students to come to Randolph-Macon's campus in Ashland, Virginia and learn about the intersection of science and faith in the classroom and through hands-on experiences. They will dive deeper into their faith, deeper into the study of science, and meet other high school students and Randolph-Macon College student counselors with those same interests. The cost to participate is only \$100 for this 9-day program.
