

ARTICULATION DEVELOPMENT

This chart shows at what age 90% of boys and girls can articulate the English consonants correctly. Vowels are correctly produced by age three. All children do not develop at the same time and in the same way, so we cannot expect correct speech, from every child in the primary grades

The following sources were consulted for development of these norms: Poole, Sander, Hejana, Fudala, Templin and Wellman.

Normative data suggests a difference between boys and girls.
