

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 6TH GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Contact parents of children who have not been saved.
2. Continue to discuss the Roman Road to Salvation.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, grow in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Learn divisions of the Bible.
2. Use Daily Bible Readings.
3. Develop skills in effectively handling the Bible and locating key passages.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Discuss ways to join church.
2. Have outside resource people to visit - deacons, secretaries, janitors, committee members.
3. Visit T.V. room and have someone to explain the ministry.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that they can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Discuss prayer list from Wednesday prayer service.
2. Understand parts of prayer with the Lord's Prayer as a model.

WORSHIP ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church.

1. Discuss Order of Worship.
2. Understand reason for each part.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love for him through a study of the scriptures.

1. Psalm 23. Recite Psalm 23.
2. Sermon on the Mount.
Continue study and memorization.
3. Ten Commandments.
Develop an understanding of how the Ten Commandments relate to pupils' lives today as opposed to life during Biblical times.

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 5TH GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form at least once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Talk to each child, individually, about Salvation.
2. Encourage each child to make a decision.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, grow in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Name the books of the Bible.
2. Identify and locate the divisions of the Bible (history, law, prophet, gospels, letters).
3. Develop skills in effectively handling the Bible and locating key passages.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Visit baptistry.
2. Discuss different ways to join church.
3. Learn other people in church who have important jobs - secretaries, deacons, janitors, etc.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that they can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Memorize Lord's Prayer.
2. Lead in closing prayer.

WORSHIP ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church.

1. Discuss Order of Worship in Sunday morning worship.
2. Understand each part of service.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love of him through a study of the scriptures.

1. Psalm 23. Memorize and discuss the meaning of 23rd Psalm.
2. Sermon on the Mount.
 - A. Locate and read the Sermon on the Mount.
 - B. Begin to memorize this passage.
3. Ten Commandments.
Memorize all of the Ten Commandments.

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 4TH GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form at least once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Begin study of Roman Road to Salvation.
2. Romans 3:23; 6:23; 5:8; 10:9-10, 13.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, grow in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Name in order the books of the Old Testament.
2. Be familiar with the divisions of the Old Testament.
3. Develop skills in effectively handling the Bible, locating books and verse.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Discuss tithing - why we do it and how the money is used.
2. Look at monthly business report as presented to church.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that he can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Locate and mark prayer promises - Matthew 7:7; Jeremiah 33:3; John 15:7; Matthew 21:22; 1 John 5:14-15.
2. Memorize 3 of the above verses.
3. Be aware of church prayer list and prayer room.

WORSHIP ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church, particularly the Lord's Supper.

1. Learn the meaning and purpose of the Lord's Supper.
2. Have a Deacon show Lord's Supper utensils.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love of him through the study of scriptures.

1. Psalm 23.
Memorize verses 1 - 3 of Psalm 23.
2. Sermon on the Mount
Locate and read the Sermon on the Mount.
3. The Great Commission.
Locate and memorize Matthew 28:19-20.
4. Ten Commandments.
 1. Locate and read the Ten Commandments.
 2. Discuss the meaning of Commandments 1 - 5 as they deal with the child's relationship with God.

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 1ST GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form at least once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Locate and read John 3:16 and talk about the meaning.
2. Highlight John 3:16 in individual Bibles.
3. Receive a bookmark of John 3:16.
4. Read together John 3:16 at least once a month.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, grow in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Establish habit of bringing own Bible to Sunday School.
2. Name the two divisions of the Bible.
3. Learn general arrangement of Bible.
4. Develop skills in locating weekly memory verses.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Emphasize giving regularly.
2. Explain why offering is brought.
3. Tour church building.
4. Invite church staff members to meet the children and have children become familiar with their names.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that he can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Have each child participate in sentence prayers.
2. Have each child say from memory James 5:16 and explain its meaning.

WORSHIP ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church.

1. Explain and discuss a printed order of service for a Sunday Worship Service.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love for him through a study of the scriptures.

1. Psalm 23.
Emphasize God's continuous love and care by reading Psalm 23.
2. The Golden Rule.
Locate, discuss and highlight Luke 6:31.
3. The Ten Commandments.
Present background material on the Ten Commandments.

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 3RD GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form at least once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Memorize and show understanding of Romans 3:23.
2. Discuss Bible stories about Paul's conversion, Philip and the Ethiopian, Pentecost, the Easter story.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, grow in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Name in order the books of the New Testament.
2. Begin to identify the division of the Bible in which a book belongs (history, law, prophets, gospels, letters).
3. Develop skills by locating memory verses each week.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Emphasize the importance of giving regularly.
2. Be familiar with church staff.
3. Be familiar with church building.
4. Learn different ways people can join the church - baptism, statement, letter.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that he can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Locate in the Bible and memorize the Lord's Prayer.

WORSHIP ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church, particularly baptism.

1. Learn what baptism is, why we do it and what it means.
2. Visit the baptistry.
3. Discuss Jesus' baptism.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love of him through a study of the scriptures.

1. Psalm 23.
Locate and discuss the meaning of the 23rd Psalm.
2. The Golden Rule.
Locate and memorize Matthew 7:12 and Ephesians 4:32.
3. The Ten Commandments.
Locate the Ten Commandments in the Bible.

TEACHING OBJECTIVES - 2ND GRADE

PLAN OF SALVATION

Each child will be presented with the Plan of Salvation in some form at least once each month at his level of understanding.

1. Say from memory John 3:16.
2. Discuss the need for salvation - study Romans 3:23.
3. Establish Jesus as The Way to Salvation - study John 3:17 and John 14:6.

USE OF THE BIBLE

Each child will develop skills in using the Bible, growing in knowledge of the organization of the Bible and establish a desire to commit verses to memory.

1. Establish habit of bringing own Bible to Sunday School.
2. Become familiar with the books of the Bible.
3. Develop skills in locating weekly memory verses.

THE CHURCH - THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Each child will grow in understanding of the essential elements that allow a church to exist.

1. Emphasize importance of giving regularly.
2. Invite staff members to talk to children about their responsibilities.
3. Know by name staff members of Calvary.

PRAYER

Each child will have a better understanding of what prayer is, that he can pray anytime, anywhere, and that Jesus taught us to pray.

1. Explain and say from memory Psalm 55:17.
2. Discuss times to pray.

DISCUSS ORDINANCES

Each child will develop an understanding of the worship ordinances of the church, including the Order of Worship and the Doxology.

1. Discuss an Order of Worship from Calvary.
2. Explain the Doxology and learn to sing it.

SCRIPTURES

Each child will grow in understanding of Christian attitudes toward others and of God's continuous love of him through a study of the scriptures.

1. Psalm 23.
 - A. Locate the 23rd Psalm.
 - B. Understand the meaning of God's care through His Word.
2. The Golden Rule.
Say from memory Luke 6:31.
3. The Ten Commandments.
Present background material to this passage through the study of the story of Moses.
