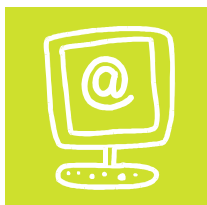

When you send out an email to a group of people, it is courteous to put the list of people in the **BCC** field, rather than the **To** field. **BCC** stands for Blind Courtesy Copy, and ensures that the email addresses will not be revealed to everyone receiving the email. Put your own address in the **To** field to ensure yours is the only address shown. If you do not see the **BCC** field, check your menu under View or Options. (K-5 – 2nd Grade)

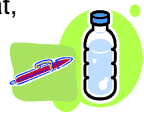


(3rd – 6th grade)
