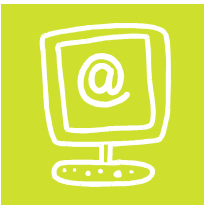

Put your own address in the **To** field to ensure yours is the only address shown. If you do not see the **BCC** field, check your menu under View or Options.
