Through the service of these committee members, we are able to provide a safe, clean, efficient, and barrier free church.

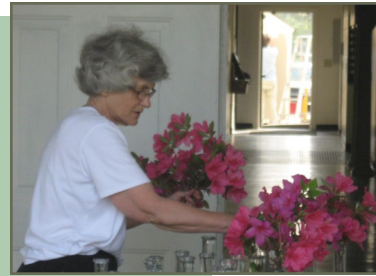
