

WHAT AM I BEING ASKED TO DO?

The Capital Campaign raises the same question for every SVPC household.

How much should I give to the Capital Campaign?

First, we must seek to follow the Apostle Paul's advice to the Corinthian Church: "Each one must do as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (II Cor. 9:7) It is the prayer of the Capital Campaign Committee that your participation in this campaign will be an occasion for joy and not an occasion for discouragement.

Second, we invite those who are able, to make their gift out of your accumulated resources. Traditionally, these gifts are given out of long-term savings, appreciated stock, marketable properties, etc. If you are able and feel called to do so, please plan to participate by making a gift out of your accumulated resources.

Third, we recognize that not everyone has accumulated resources. Many households live from paycheck to paycheck. If this is your situation, we ask that you consider a sacrificial gift that is in the range of 2.5 times your annual pledge. This would be paid out over three years.

EXAMPLE of a \$7500.00 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PLEDGE

2008 Annual Pledge of \$3000 x 2.5 = \$7500 / 3 years = \$2500

Fourth, we realize that some households will be unable to make a pledge that is 2.5 times the amount of your annual pledge. Others will feel unable to make any commitment at this time. Please don't concern yourself. When the opportunity is given, pledge at the level you can and join us in giving thanks to God for all who are called to join in this great enterprise. We welcome spontaneous gifts made at any time during the campaign. If you cannot make a pledge, simply return the Capital Campaign Pledge Form and indicate your decision to not pledge at this time. We ask that everyone return their pledge form, those who pledge as well as those who do not pledge.

Fifth, please pray for this effort. Many SVPC households are working hard to prepare for our future by gaining freedom from debt.

Sixth, consider making a Planned Gift to Spring Valley to help retire the debt and/or to fund a mission or ministry which you feel called to support beyond your lifetime. During the campaign you will receive a Gift Planning Guide which outlines a variety of ways you can use your Last Will and Testament to support the ministry of your church.
