They will also provide additional occasions for us to nurture and strength ourselves to carry out Christ’s work in the world. Of course, our favorite and time-honored ministries will continue to flourish at St. Boniface.

We’ll enjoy new— and familiar—ways to deepen our understanding of who we are as God’s people and followers of Jesus. Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings will bring new classes, lectures and speakers, covering the basics of our faith and special topics. Next year our choir will grow with the addition of choral scholars, 8th—12th graders who have auditioned for these three positions. With the Siesta Youth Chorale music enrichment program, we are reaching out with the joy of music to children in our community.

Looking ahead to 2019, we envision an abundant year of favorite ministries enriched with fresh ways of reaching in and reaching out as we grow in God’s love.

Worship and Ministries ~ These are the ways we pray, worship, proclaim the gospel and strengthen ourselves to promote justice, peace and love.

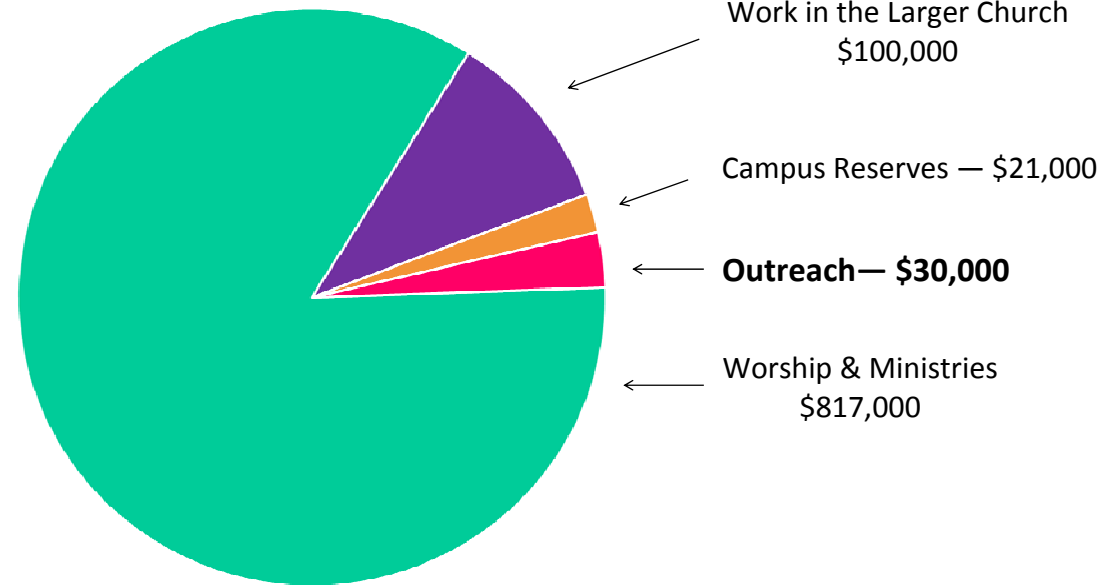
Work in the Larger Church ~ These are the ways we grow the Church locally in our diocese and nationally.
