We would love to have your child in our Weekday Education Program! Now is the time to sign up. We will be enrolling very soon for our part-time fall programs for children who are 8 weeks until 5 years (until the children go to kindergarten). Registration is first-come first-serve and spaces are limited.

We are pleased to announce that the tuition rates will remain the same as this school year!

Our Preschool Program runs from September through May from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. each day. There are many choices of days to attend that are listed on the attached tuition rate sheet. Our preschool program closes for two weeks in December and a week in the spring.

We use the Wee Learn curriculum to teach to all areas of a child's development (social, emotional, cognitive, fine motor, gross motor, and spiritual). Our teachers do a fabulous job of varying the lesson plans to accommodate the variety of developmental levels and personalities in each classroom.

Age and readiness factors play into which class is best for each child. To determine which class is the correct placement for your child we have the following guidelines:

Because of the guidelines from the state of NC, for the public school systems, beginning August 2009, all children entering kindergarten must be 5 years of age on or before August 31st. To comply with these guidelines and make a smooth transition for the children enrolled in our center, we are trying to implement these guidelines too. Parents with children with birthdays in September or October can make the decision to repeat the age group in which they are currently enrolled or continue to the next class. If your child continues to the next age group, they will just attend our Transitional Kindergarten program after the four year old class. If you have questions about the best choice for your child, please discuss them with your child's teacher or Kelly in the office!

Our infant class serves children beginning at 8 weeks old. Children's individual schedules for sleeping, eating, changing and play are followed.

Our toddler class is more structured. There is a daily classroom routine of play, outside time, songs, art, stories and lunch. Children in this class are at least 12 months at the beginning of the school year and must be off the bottle and not require a morning nap.

Our two year old classes continue to focus on the whole child with a daily routine. Speaking more and potty training are big skills at this age level.

In our three year old classes, children need to be potty trained. In this age group, life outside the classroom begins with attending chapel and "Stretch and Grow". Children at this age are big talkers and have a longer attention span and therefore activities can be more complex!

Our four year old classes have an additional component in the form of the Letter People curriculum. This is a multi sensory curriculum that teaches letters and their sounds. All children who have graduated from our program leave ready for Kindergarten!

Our Transitional Kindergarten is for children who have completed the four year old program and miss the cut off date for the schools or for children who might need an extra year before Kindergarten. It expands on the four year old curriculum to continue learning in all areas of development.

Registration for those currently enrolled in our program:

- The non-refundable registration fee for the fall program for church members is \$50.00 and for non-members is \$75.00.

Registration for church members not yet in our program:

- The non-refundable registration fee for the fall program for church members is \$50.00.

Registration for the community: The non-refundable registration fee is \$75.00.

TK registration only:

The registration fees remain the same as above and the first month's non-refundable tuition (\$350) is also required at the time of registration.
