A Ministry of St. Philip’s Men’s Group

Recognizing that many members of St. Philip’s jump in to help others in need, there is merit in organizing a ministry to whom those in need can turn when a little help is needed.

Who we will help within our parish:

- Those living alone who need an extra pair of hands for odd jobs
- Those who are elderly...
- Those with physical limitations....
- Those where a loved one has an illness or an accident, and the partner is occupied with giving care and does not have time to handle necessary odd jobs.

What we will do:

As a pastoral ministry, to help members of St. Philip’s family who are in need, by performing odd jobs as practical support during difficult times. These are jobs which need to be done, or would make a difference in the person’s life, but cannot easily be found through a commercial service. For example:

- Moving a piece of furniture from one room to another
- Bringing down items from the attic, including Christmas trees
- Helping put up a Christmas tree
- Storing portable yard items/porch furniture in the garage, in advance of a bad storm
- Other odd jobs as requested, and which can appropriately be performed by the Odd Jobbers.

The Odd Jobbers will respond as quickly as practical, and as much notice as possible will be encouraged.

Please note: The Odd Jobbers are not intended to be a substitute for locally available commercial services, e.g., electricians, plumbers, lawn care services, roof problems, etc.
