2. Life Development Classes: Classes offered for Men, Women & Couples equipping them to live out their faith on a day to day basis.

Children: AWANA

Awana is an exciting Bible-based program for children age two through fifth grade. Children are challenged through competition and individual instruction to commit the Bible to memory. Meeting times are on Sunday evenings from 5:30-7:00 p.m. Childcare is provided for children birth to toddlers.

Youth: Discipleship Groups

(DGroups) are grade-based small groups that seek to take the students deeper into God's Word. They are meant to challenge the students, but also to provide them with an opportunity to ask questions about what it means to follow Christ.
