Math

We are reviewing basic multiplication and division, along with learning how to average numbers and do short division. Please review the multiplication facts with your student.

Spelling

We will have our first Spelling Test today. I will also be using the Spelling Test as a Handwriting Test each week. Please encourage your student to write slowly and neatly.

Language

We are covering the subjects and verbs of sentences. Please review your student's language pages with them. Read them a sentence from their book and have them tell you what the subject is and what the verb(s) are. Please also review the Helping Verbs and State of Being verbs. These can be overlooked at times. The students have been taught that each sentence will have a subject and at least one verb.

Reading

We will begin having Reading Vocabulary and Comprehension quizzes on Fridays. The students will be given 10 vocab words on Monday. Please review with them these words each night. The comprehension questions will come from their reading of *Beyond the Horizons* book. Please encourage your student to read a book outside of class. Also, please have your student read out loud to you at least twice a week. You will be able to help them with fluency and inflection.

We have been studying Ephesians 6:10-12. Our Bible Study of these passages is going well. I think the students are more aware that Satan wants to pull us away from God. And, that by asking Jesus to be with us will help with the temptations we struggle against on a daily basis.
