Swingin' Into Our Studies

Phonics:

Introduced: "Xx" (ks sound) as in fox and "Zz" as in zebra. We also started learning the blend ladders for these consonants. We also are learning about various punctuation marks, including the period, question mark and exclamation point!

Reviewed: The sounds of the following consonants and their "blend ladders": "t" in table, "l" in lamp, "b" in bell, "n" in nest, "m" in milk, "h" in horse, "s" in sun, "c" in cat, "d" in dog, "g" in goat, "r" as in ring, "f" in fox, "j" in jar, "k" in kite, "v" in violin, "w" in wagon, "y" in yarn and "p" in pig. Also, spent more time on the C/K Blend Ladder and the "ck" "special sound". Sight words: "the" and "a".

Note: Your child should be able to read and make blends and short words.

Handwriting:

Introduced: The cursive letters "x" and "z".

Reviewed: The cursive "i", "u", "e", "a", "o", "t", "l", "b", "n", "m", "h", "s", "c", "d", "g", "r", "f", "j", "k", "v", "w", "y", "p".

Remember to keep your letters on the appropriate line.

Math:

Reviewed: Numbers zero – 69. The "Fathers of the Twenty thru Sixty Families". We also worked on the Teen Family (10-19), Forty Family (40-49), Fifty Family (50-59) and Sixty Family (60-69). We practiced writing numbers one thru ten, telling Time to the Hour, "Adding One" and The Nickel!!

Introduced: The 70 Family (70-79), "After Numbers" and "Dot Cards".

Social Studies: "Our Great Country"... This week:

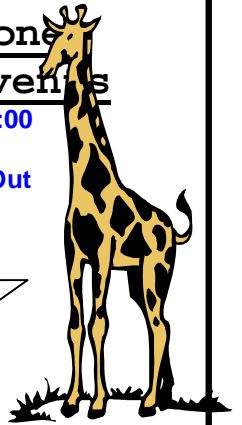
Pilgrims, Indians, Eskimos, Hawaii, and Our Flag.
