Introduced: Before numbers

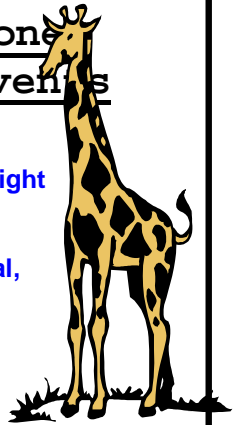
Social Studies: "Children Around the World"

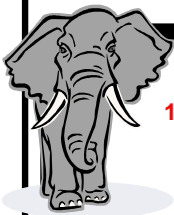
