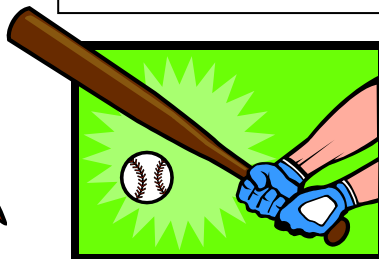
Congratulations to the Varsity Girls' Basketball Team
