

THE WILLIAM T. BLEVINS “MR. BILL’S” SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- A. The William T. Blevins “Mr. Bill’s” Scholarship shall be awarded to post-secondary students at institutions of higher learning including community colleges, colleges and universities, or professional schools, including schools of theology, law, medicine, architecture, and other similarly recognized professions.
- B. A total of \$3,000 in scholarship funds will be awarded for the 2010-2011 school year. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution. No scholarship recipient shall be awarded more than fifty (50%) percent of the funds on hand for scholarships in any one year. The scholarship may be divided among qualifying applicants.
- C. High school graduating seniors or college students must have a grade average of “C” (GPA 2.0) or better and be in good standing with the school.
- D. Scholarships will be available to members of Broad Street United Methodist Church or their children.
- E. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees of Broad Street United Methodist Church who will provide funds as appropriated.
- F. Participation in Broad Street United Methodist Church and community activities will be factors given strong consideration in awarding this scholarship. Other criteria include academic achievement, need, opportunity, desire, citizenship, and leadership qualities.
- G. In order to retain this scholarship for the entire school year, a cumulative academic average of 2.5 is required. Additionally, the recipient must be in “good standing” with the institution’s Dean of Students. This scholarship is not automatically renewed. Application must be submitted for each succeeding school year.
- H. All application materials (including application form, three letters of recommendation, essay, and official transcript(s)) for the scholarship must be submitted to the church office by **MARCH 31ST** or postmarked by that date. **LATE APPLICATIONS OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT CONSIDERED.** Applicants will be notified of the scholarship award decision no later than May 31st.
