The Lenten season is a time of preparation, reflection, growth and change. The word 'Lent' comes from the Anglo-Saxon word that means "spring" or springtime." Taken literally, the word means that this is the time of the year when the days lengthen.

Lent is a 40-day long period, not counting Sundays, leading up to Easter Sunday. All Sundays are considered "little Easters," celebrating the resurrection.
