- ◆ Family Promise will continue on a permanent basis. The next quarterly time that BSUMC will host is February 5-12.
- ◆ Our proposed budget for 2012 was accepted at \$1,123,069.00. Seventy-nine percent of the 2012 budget has been pledged.
- ◆ Due to state regulations the Children's Learning Center Program will begin opening only two days a week in June.
- ◆ Johnston Woods has a new sign on Highway 11, a new disc golf course and will continue housing mission tornado recovery volunteers if it does not interfere with paying customers.
