NFL controversy aside, I got a charge out of hearing Texas born and reared Vikings quarterback Case Keenum's brief interview after the "Minnesota Miracle" got his team into the NFC Championship game. When a last-second pass to give the team's kicker a better chance at a field goal turned into the winning touchdown, a reporter caught Keenum in the middle of the mayhem and asked the stock question, What does this moment feel like.

Case said it would "probably go down as the third-best moment in my life," ranked behind "giving my life to Jesus Christ and marrying my wife."

I got a charge out of his words for two reasons. One is that I share the same top two life moments as a winning pro quarterback. The other is that he took a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to naturally share his adoration for Jesus Christ.

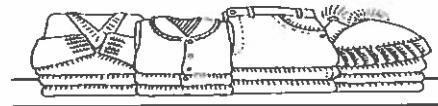

We'll be hosting an area training session for men and women to be certified as "Yellow Cap" volunteers. It will be in the Fellowship Hall from 9:15 a.m. until noon on Saturday March 3. This is a general orientation to be certified or to renew your certification. A \$40 fee and permission are required for a criminal background check.

Following the general orientation there will be special training for Shower/Laundry Units 1-3 p.m. The Tri-Rivers Baptist Area Laundry Unit has been in continuous service since the hurricanes along the Texas coast. Six people have given their lives to Christ through the witness of volunteers with our Laundry Unit. Attend both training events, and you'll be prepared to get in on the adventure.
