We got an email message on Monday from our summer missionaries to Bulgaria, Jean & Bill King. The Kings left in April prepared to spend five or six months serving at the Learning Center ministry led by Judy Ridgway. To stay longer than ninety days, they need Visas. Securing those documents was difficult, and we've been praying for God to make it happen, but the latest news is that apparently no Visas will be issued as needed. (Although, there's still a "Plan B" possibility. Stay tuned.)

Their time has been fruitful, and they made it possible for Judy and Paul to take a much needed vacation, but evidently they can't do all they planned.

In their message the Kings said they, "will leave Bulgaria in July instead of September. The Bulgarian Visa Laws changed in March 2018 and doors appear to have shut. We will work hard as AMERICAN TOURISTS until it's time to return to Texas. Our titles have changed, but our goals remain the same—sharing the love of Jesus Christ with the young men at the Learning Center and the other people we come in contact with."

What a great attitude in the face of disappointment! Are you disappointed because of a "shut door"? Just keep doing what you know God wants you to do in the meantime. In Christ, we're all "tourists" in this world (1 Peter 2:9), meant to hold our plans and possessions loosely. We

belong to and represent a "better country" (Hebrews 11:10,16; 2 Corinthians 5:20). I've never seen a door shut on my option to share the love of Jesus Christ—unless I closed it myself.
