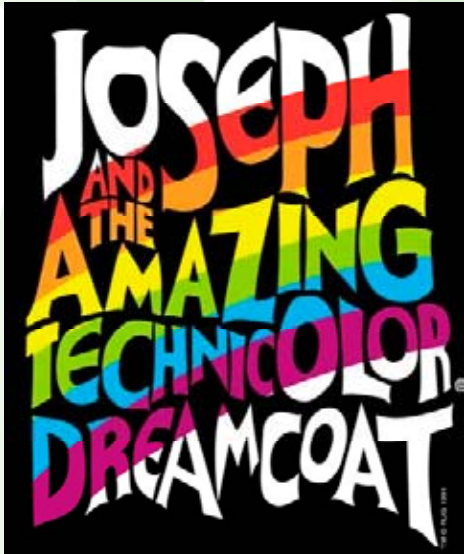

Mike Huckabee

A private reception will be held at 5:30pm. The doors open to ticket holders at 6:30pm followed by dinner at 7:00pm.

The Governor will present the case for Christian education and why it is important for the future of this nation. Following his thirty minute speech, guests will be allotted twenty minutes to ask the Governor questions. The evening will conclude with the Governor “jamming” on his 4-string bass with Mayor Rick Baker and the award winning Northside Christian School Jazz Band.

Former Arkansas Governor Mike Huckabee is the host of the number one rated weekend hit “HUCK-ABEE” on the Fox News Channel and is heard three times daily on ABC Radio Network’s “Huckabee Report,” one of the nation’s fastest growing radio programs. An author of six books, his most recent work, “Do the Right Thing,” spent its first seven weeks of release in the top ten of the New York Times Best Seller List.

Spanning a decade (1996-2007), Gov. Huckabee served as the 44th Governor of Arkansas and was recognized as a national leader by many leading publications and organizations. Prior to his service as governor, he had been elected lieutenant governor in a 1993 special election and was elected to a full four-year term in 1994.

Gov. Huckabee’s surprising campaign for the Republican nomination for President in 2008 resulted in a second place finish to Senator John McCain and established a national following for his conservative principles. Huckabee’s career before politics was spent as a denominational leader and pastor. He became the Arkansas Baptist State Convention’s youngest president and led rapidly growing congregations in Pine Bluff and Texarkana.

Huckabee is an avid musician and his hobbies include hunting and fishing. He was named one of the 25 most influential people for conservation by Outdoor Life magazine and was previously American Sportfishing Association’s Man of the Year.
