

T-NET POLICY REGARDING ASSIGNMENTS AND ATTENDANCE
(A reminder)

Church Covenant

Participating in T-NET requires commitment on the part of both the church and individual participants. To clarify expectations and underscore the importance of responsibilities connected with T-NET, it is necessary for **each** participant to read and sign this T-NET Covenant as a part of the registration process.

Attendance:

I understand that my T-NET commitment involves a 32 month period. In order to maintain continuity in the process and ensure a successful training experience, I commit to attend all meetings.

In unavoidable circumstances, such as illness or extraordinary situations, where I am unable to attend, I will secure a substitute to take my place.

Task Force:

I understand that my participation in T-NET automatically makes me a part of our church's discipling task force. As a part of this task force, I commit to faithfully attend its regularly scheduled meetings between training center meetings for the purpose of praying for, planning, and implementing our church's discipling plan.

Homework:

I understand that everyone in T-NET will be involved in practical homework assignments in two broad areas - general reading and task assignments. I commit to completing these assignments on time and to the best of my ability.

Accountability:

I understand that compliance with these commitments is essential for participation in T-NET. I give permission for T-NET and my church to hold me accountable in these areas. As a part of this accountability, I understand that if I do not comply with these commitments, I may be requested to provide an explanation. If warranted, an official warning will be issued. I further understand that a second violation of any of the above commitments may necessitate the replacement of an individual on our T-NET team or even forfeit our church's privilege to continue in the T-NET process.
