**Covenant of Behavior**  
**Senior High California Trip**  
**Thursday, February 25<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

In order to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip experience for all participants, we have established the following guidelines for your student(s) while they are under our care on the California Trip. We encourage you to discuss the guidelines with your son or daughter before signing and returning this form to the Youth Department at El Camino Baptist Church.

The only rule that Pastor Stuart has for this trip is: **RESPECT**. Respect for yourself. Respect for others. Respect for other people's property. Respect for God. To better define what **RESPECT** on this trip looks like, we have provided the following guidelines:

**Clothing/Dress**

Clothing should be free of controversial or inappropriate writing, slogans or pictures (i.e. alcohol-themed logos, vulgar words, etc.).  
Underwear (including waistbands) should not be visible above pants/shorts.  
Clothing should be modest at all times. Excessively short shorts or skirts, low cut tops or tight clothing is not appropriate. One-piece, modest bathing suits for girls and appropriately modest bathing suits for boys is expected.  
Pastor Stuart and the Adult Youth Leaders will make the final determination of what is or is not appropriate.  
Students wearing inappropriate clothing during this trip may be asked to change into appropriate clothes or cover up inappropriate clothes.

**Sleeping Arrangements**

Students will be assigned to rooms with a leader and other students. We will attempt to place your son or daughter into the room of their choice, but circumstances may not make this possible.  
Boys and girls are NEVER allowed into opposite gender rooms under ANY circumstances.  
“Lights Out” & “Quiet Times” will be clearly communicated to students and strictly enforced.

**When not in the hotel**

Pastor Stuart MUST approve any student(s) being outside the hotel for any reason.  
Students will travel in groups of three (or more) at all times – no exceptions.  
Pastor Stuart and the Adult Youth Leaders may, at their discretion, reassign students to other groups.

**Restricted Items/Behaviors**

Students will refrain from smoking, using illegal drugs (or using prescription drugs illegally) or consuming alcoholic beverages.  
Students may not be in possession of cigarettes, cigars, knives, guns, weapons, alcohol, pornography (printed or digital) as well as music or video games that would be considered by Pastor Stuart and the Adult Youth Staff to be objectionable.

**Schedule**

Every student will be given written trip schedule and students are expected to be on time and at ALL scheduled events throughout the trip.  
Students will check in at all designated check in times while at the theme parks.

**Violation of any of these guidelines may, at the sole discretion of Pastor Stuart, result in the student being sent home early from the trip at the expense of their parent(s)!**

# WHAT TO TAKE ON THE HIGH SCHOOL CALIFORNIA TRIP

Sunglasses

Toiletry items (shampoo, deodorant, etc)

Sunscreen (if you burn easily)

Clothing for 3 days. Bring your bathing suit if you want to swim! When we get to California, we will be going directly to the beach. If you want to swim, please wear your bathing suit under your clothes, or put it in a carry-on and keep with you on the bus. There will be restrooms at the beach to change your clothes.

**PLEASE bring warm clothing like sweatshirts and pants and jacket!** Please bring a modest bathing suit or wear a large or extra large t-shirt over your swimsuit.

Comfortable shoes – preferably tennis shoes and socks. Not only will we be doing a lot of walking, but it will be colder there than here in Tucson.

There will be times when you will be able to listen to your I-pod, CD players, etc. Please only bring appropriate music (nothing with inappropriate content).

If you bring your portable DVD player, please bring your earphones. You are welcome to bring movies rated G, PG or PG13. **Due to the content of some PG13 movies, you may be asked not to watch it on the trip.**

**Please do not bring laptops unless you need it for homework.**

**Please keep a close eye on your personal belongings, (I-pods, etc). El Camino Baptist Church, its staff and leaders are not responsible for items being lost, stolen or damaged.**

Snacks- El Camino does not allow soda's, drinks with sugar, glass containers or gum on the bus or vans. Please bring water only.
